

LUNCH WITH A JUDGE

On Wednesday, January 11, the **Honorable Robert B. Kershaw**, Judge In-Charge of the Juvenile Court of the Circuit Court for Baltimore City will be the Bar Library's guest speaker in a new series that the Library recently launched in September, "Lunch With A Judge." Judge Kershaw will be presenting "Juvenile Justice – Prologue to Practice." The afternoon will feature an interactive discussion of juvenile court legal practice within the context of delinquency, child welfare and dependency cases. Judge Kershaw will highlight how experience gained in juvenile proceedings carries over to criminal, civil and family law practices.

Honorable Robert B. Kershaw has served on the Baltimore City Circuit Court, 8th Judicial Circuit, since February 6, 2006, in the capacity of Judge-in-Charge, Juvenile Division, since January 2011. In addition, he is a Member of the Foster Care Court-Improvement Implementation Committee, 2012-; Member, Juvenile Law Committee, Judicial Council, 2015-; and Member, Commission on Judicial Disabilities, 2016-.
